Last question – in a perfect world, what kind of a dog do you envision being the perfect fit for your lifestyle in terms of energy, drive, temperament and personality features? There are no “wrong” answers! This will just help us get an idea of which breeding pair would likely produce puppies best suited to your wants & needs.

All of our puppies are sold on thorough, legally binding contracts to protect the puppy for their lifetime – this means that you get LIFETIME Breeder Support from us and in the event that the puppy you purchase ever needs to be re-homed, we are to be contacted and involved in the re-homing process and/or can take the puppy back to re-home ourselves.

Completing this application is the first step to acquiring a puppy from Border City Bullies, but it does not guarantee that you will get a puppy from a future litter. While it is unlikely, the Breeder reserves the right to refuse placement at any time throughout this process.

CONTRACT TYPES:

Pet Home - Requires the puppy to be spay/neutered at 24-36 months of age, puppy will NEVER be bred under any circumstances. Puppy must be OFA Hip, OFA Elbow & OFA Cardiac tested at 24-36 months of age. This is our most sought after ownership method and what most puppies leave under.

Co-Own – Breeder retains full or partial breeding rights to the puppy. Owner can be as involved or uninvolved as they want. Each co-ownership agreement is unique and tailored to fit each home's wants/needs. There are health testing, titling and general ethics requirements that may be fulfilled by the Breeder, Owner, or both. We usually find 1-2 Co-Own homes for each litter we have and our "keeper" puppy from outside breedings. These homes get first priority.

Full Rights – Buyer purchases full breeding rights to a puppy to breed the dog as they see fit with no involvement from the Breeder. There are health testing, titling and general ethics requirements that may be fulfilled by the Owner before full ownership will be signed over and permission to breed will be granted.

APPROVAL: We will review applications within 5 business days of being received. We will notify you within 5-20 business days regarding your application and the next steps moving forward. Don't fret if you haven't been contacted quickly – sometimes there are technical issues or we get swamped. If you haven't heard anything, just send us an email!

PUPPY PRICING: Our puppy price on all contract types is \$3,000 USD – the Canadian exchange rate changes daily, but on average this is approximately \$3,850 CAD. We do not "up charge" for colour, markings, gender, or contract type.

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT: Once the contract has been signed and puppies have been born, approved homes will receive a link to make a 20% holding deposit (\$600 USD) on a puppy. These links will be sent out in the order of approved applications suitable to the unique litter (number of pups born, gender, contract type, etc). Deposit must be received within 48 hours of the link being sent. The remainder is to be paid by the time the puppy reaches 6 weeks of age. All payments can be made via PayPal or eTransfer for Canadian residents.

YOUR "PICK" OF PUPPY: Puppies will be placed in the order the Breeder makes, NOT in the order of applications or deposits received. There is no such thing as 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc pick puppies here – the way we do it, everyone gets their "1st pick" for their wants, needs and lifestyle. This is done to ensure that puppies get the absolute best homes possible based on their individual temperaments. These choices are made after we have completed our 3rd party APET Temperament Evaluations and Puppy Puzzle Conformation Evaluations at 8 weeks of age. We use the results from these evaluations to pair each puppy with the ideal home for them and vice versa – though we appreciate that people may have colour preferences, it would be irresponsible for us to home a puppy based on colour/markings alone if it is not the best fit for the lifestyle/wants/needs of the owner (for example – a high energy dog in the colour they want, being homed to a family whose lifestyle accommodates a strictly low energy dog). Having colour preferences is fine, but just be aware that it may take a little longer to find the perfect puppy for you if you are unwilling to budge on the colour. We understand that this is different than the vast majority of breeders in our breed, and it is for good reason...this is a 10+ year commitment on both ends of the leash, and it is our responsibility as a Breeder to do everything in our power to set both up for success.
